- The Nicaraguan coffees are from the Flor de Dalia and Flor de Pancasán cooperatives in the country’s Matagalpa coffee-growing region and are graded as Hard Bean. To learn more about the producers, visit etico.ca

- Seaforth needs 48 hours’ notice for a regular pick up. Rush orders can be processed for a \$66.64 surcharge. Seaforth charges a \$35 minimum handling fee for loading out.
