- The organic coffee is both NOP and COR certified.*
  - CCDA transitional coffee is grown without synthetic pesticides, herbicides and fertilizers, but has not yet achieved organic certification.*
- Pick up at the Seaforth SCS coffee warehouse at 7167 Progress Way, Delta, BC, tel: 604-420-0065.
  - Seaforth needs 48 hours’ notice for a regular pick up. They will process rush orders for a surcharge. Seaforth charges a \$41 minimum handling fee for loading out. Palletize - Wrap/2strap = \$45.70 per pallet (up to 9 bags).
  - Payment can be made by e-transfer or sent by cheque or money order to Café Justicia and mailed to the address above. We can also process credit card payments, but there is a 1.3% surcharge. To pay by credit card, please let us know when you order so we can activate the option on your invoice.
