Café Justicia is produced in Guatemala's Atitlán region by the Campesino Committee of the Highlands (CCDA) and is graded as Strictly Hard Bean (SHB-EP). To learn more about the producers, visit cafejusticia.ca.

All prices are in Canadian dollars. To compare with the US pricing that most importers charge, divide our price by 1.4.

1. The organic coffee is both NOP and COR certified.
2. CCDA transitional coffee is grown without synthetic pesticides, herbicides and fertilizers, but has not yet achieved organic certification.

- Pick up at the Seaforth SCS coffee warehouse at 7167 Progress Way, Delta, BC, tel: 604-420-0065.
- Seaforth needs 48 hours' notice for a regular pick up. They will process rush orders for a surcharge. Seaforth charges a \$63 minimum handling fee for loading out (incl GST). Palletize - Wrap/2strap = \$89.25 per pallet (max. 10 bags, incl GST).
- Payment can be made by e-transfer or sent by cheque or money order to Café Justicia and mailed to the address above. We can also process credit card payments, but there is a 2.9% surcharge. To pay by credit card, please let us know when you order so we can activate the option on your invoice.
- Terms of payment are Net 30. An interest rate of .5% per month will be charged on overdue payments.
